Subject: Haryana Inter-School Shooting Championship 2026 (Air Weapons)

Dear All,

In accordance with the decision made by the Governing Body of the Haryana Rifle Association, the Haryana Inter-School Shooting Championship 2026 (Air Weapons) will be held at the **Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, Tughlakabad, New Delhi**, from **09 to 11 June 2026**.

The detailed program for the championship is attached herewith as **Appendix "A"**.

General Instructions:

1. All matches will be conducted in accordance with the "NRAI Match Book 2024 (as of 21.10.25)" under N.R. Rules.
2. The Match Book is available for reference on the official websites: thehra.co.in and thenrai.in.

2. REQUIREMENT: Verification Letter from the Concerned School

A verification letter from the respective school is mandatory for participation.

- **Note:** Recognizing that most schools are closed for summer vacation during the month of May, athletes are conditionally permitted to submit their entries online. However, the official verification letter must be submitted to the Association before the final results are published.

3. ELIGIBILITY: Qualification Criteria

- **Restricted Entry:** Freshers, newcomers, and athletes who failed to qualify in the HSCC 2025 or the HPSC 2025 are not eligible to participate in this championship.
- **Exception:** In the event an athlete failed to qualify for or did not participate in a 5th Haryana Shooting competition, they may be permitted to participate based on their official scores from the State Championship 2025.

3. EVENTS

The detailed list of matches and events is attached for your reference as **Appendix "B"**.

5. ENTRY FORM AND FEE

a. Shooter's ID:

Shooter's ID must be applied before submitting the entry.

b. Online Entry Submission:

- Entries will be accepted exclusively through the **NRAI Online System**. No paper entries will be accepted.
- Athletes are required to visit the NRAI website at www.thenrai.org to complete their online registration.
- **Standard Deadline:** The entry fee must be paid by **May 20, 2026, before 5:30 PM**.
- **Late Entry:** Entries with a **triple entry fee** will be accepted until **May 23, 2026, before 5:30 PM**.
- **Refund Policy:** Entry fees once paid are non-refundable under any circumstances.

c. Competitor Cards:

Athletes may print their Competitor Cards starting from **May 24, 2026**. It is mandatory to carry a physical copy of this card to the shooting range for the duration of the competition.

d. Venue Access:

Entry to the competition venue will be **strictly prohibited** for any athlete who does not possess a valid Competitor Card.

e. Responsibility for Accuracy:

Athletes are solely responsible for ensuring that all match details and scores provided in the online entry form are accurate. The Haryana Rifle Association (HRA) will not be held liable for any errors submitted by the applicant.

f. Penalties for False Information:

If any submitted information is found to be false—even after the competition has concluded or results have been published—the athlete's results and certificates may be withheld. Disciplinary action may also be taken in accordance with the NRAI Match Book.

g. Issuance of Certificates:

A valid Shooter ID is mandatory for the issuance of any participation or merit certificates. Certificates will not be issued without a verified ID.

h. Age Categories for 2026:

Athletes who fall within the following age brackets during the year 31 December 2026 are eligible to participate in their respective categories:

- **Juniors:** Under 19 years
- **Youth:** Under 18 years
- **Sub-Youth:** Under 15 years

i. Schedule Adjustments:

The Association reserves the right to reduce or extend the competition dates depending on the total volume of entries received.

j. Athletes are required to enter the range at least **90 minutes prior** to their reporting time to ensure timely participation in their respective details

k. Competition Format:

Please note that Finals will not be conducted for any event in this championship.

6. TEAMS

- Each school is permitted to field only **one team per category**.
- The Team Entry Form is attached as **Appendix "C"**.
- It is mandatory to submit the completed Team Entry Form by **02 June 2026, no later than 12:00 PM**.

7. COVID-19 GUIDELINES

All participants must adhere to the latest health and safety protocols and guidelines issued by the Government of India and the Delhi State Government at the time of the event.

8. ELIGIBILITY BY STATE

Participation is strictly restricted to athletes from **Haryana**. Guest shooters or athletes registered with other states are not permitted to participate in this competition.

9. PRIZES

a. Awarding of Medals:

The top three individual aggregate winners in each category will be awarded gold, silver, and bronze medals, respectively.

b. Minimum Qualifying Scores:

Medals will not be awarded to any athlete whose score falls below the qualifying marks prescribed under Rule 1.4 of the NRAI Match Book, regardless of their individual ranking. Grading for those who achieve the qualifying marks will proceed as per standard procedure.

c. Medal Distribution Criteria:

Individual medals will be awarded based on the number of participants who complete the full course:

- **3 Medals:** Minimum of 4 athletes.
- **2 Medals:** Minimum of 3 athletes.

- **1 Medal:** Minimum of 2 athletes.
- **No Medals:** In the case of a single entry.

10. DISPUTES AND PROTESTS

Any complaint or dispute regarding scores must be submitted in writing immediately to the Jury panel constituted by the organizers. A **Protest Fee of Rs. 500/-** must accompany the written complaint. All disputes will be resolved in accordance with the NRAI Match Book.

11. MISBEHAVIOR

Any act of indiscipline or misconduct by a participant or accompanying individuals shall render them liable for strict disciplinary action, including disqualification from the competition.

12. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

a. Cleanliness:

All spectators, coaches, parents, and athletes are required to maintain cleanliness within the shooting range premises. Littering (wrappers, bottles, etc.) is strictly prohibited, and the associated player may be penalized for non-compliance.

b. Compliance:

All participants must carefully read and ensure strict adherence to all instructions provided in this circular.

c. Competitor Card Fee:

A fee of **Rs. 236/- (Rs. 200/- + 18% GST)** will be charged if a Competitor Card is issued by the HRA.

d. Discipline:

Participants are expected to abide by all Championship rules. Discipline, both on and off the field, is mandatory.

e. Emergency Authority:

Organizers reserve the right to stop any match or event in case of an emergency without prior notice or assigning a reason.

f. Refund Policy:

The entry fee will not be refunded if a competitor fails to participate or does not fulfil the requirements after the entry has been submitted.

g. Liability:

The HRA shall not be held responsible for any accident or harm caused by a participant to themselves or any other person at the range.

h. Indemnity:

No participant or representative shall make any claim against the Haryana Rifle Association for any injury or accident sustained at the shooting range.

i. Range Safety:

Strict safety regulations must be observed. Weapons must not be loaded or fired until the competitor is on the firing line and the Range Officer gives the appropriate command. All weapons must be carried with bolts/actions open at all times when not on the firing line.

j. Misconduct:

Athletes providing false information regarding their date of birth or found using unfair means/indiscipline may be debarred from all shooting championships for a period of **two years**.

k. Weapon Practice:

Participants are strictly warned against practicing with weapons in hotels or other public places.
